Course Overview

SHB30315 The Certificate III in Nail Technology is a nationally recognised qualification under the Hairdressing and Beauty Services Training package (SHB).

This qualification has been designed for those individuals who wish to be employed as a nail technician to provide manicure and pedicure services, including the application and use of nail art, electric drill, acrylic and gel nail enhancements.. These individuals possess a range of well-developed technical customer and service skills where discretion and judgement is required and are responsible for their own work outputs. This includes client consultations on nail care products and services. Nail technicians may also be self-employed and responsible for managing their own nail station. Work is typically conducted in a nail or beauty salon.

The Certificate III in Nail Technology may also be utilised as a stepping stone to higher qualifications in beauty therapy or related industries.

Course Duration

1 day per week or 2 evenings per week for 14 weeks

Tuition Cost Payment Options

Payment in Full \$2,000: \$1,500 deposit on enrolment and balance of \$500 to be paid at stage 2 of enrolment.
