Course Duration

Course Cost

Payment in Full \$750 - \$300 deposit on enrolment and balance paid prior to course commencement.

Student Requirements

Uniforms: WA Academy uniform top to be worn with black professional pants and enclosed black shoes.

Hair units: Students will be required to supply their own professional blow-dryer, GHD or equivalent ironing and curling appliances, Brushes and combs.

Portfolio: WA Academy utilizes in some units portfolios, assignments and log books to allow formative assessment through the duration of the qualification these are completed outside of class and at the students cost.

On successful completion of these units you will receive a Statement of Attainment for the units in partial completion of SHB30215 Certificate III in Make-up.
