This qualification has been designed for those individuals who wish to be employed as beauticians, providing a range of beauty services including waxing, intimate waxing, lash and brow treatments, manicure, pedicure, tanning, basic make-up services, eyelash extensions as well as advising on beauty products and services and all the employability skills required to undertake this position to the highest level.

SHB30115 The Certificate III in Beauty Services may also be utilised as a stepping stone to higher qualifications. Suggested qualifications are SHB40115 Certificate IV in SHB50115 Beauty Therapy or Diploma of Beauty Therapy.

Course Duration

Part Time option 1 day or 2 evenings per week – 34 weeks.

Tuition Cost Payment Options

Student Requirements

Uniforms: WA Academy have a set uniform for this qualification and the uniform is compulsory for attendance. Allow approximately \$300 for a beauty tunic and dress pants. Uniforms are purchased direct from our Uniform supplier information available on enrolment.

Beauty units: Students will be required to supply a towelling body wrap and headband for beauty units.

Make-up units: Students will be required to supply mascara.

Portfolio: WA Academy utilizes in some units portfolios, assignments and log books to allow formative assessment through the duration of the qualification these are completed outside of class and at the students cost.


