Course Overview

The Spa Specialist Program is part of the Diploma of Beauty Therapy (SHB50115) under the Hairdressing and Beauty Services Training package (SHB).


This program has been designed for those individuals who wish to be employed as beauty/day spa specialists specialising in body treatments, providing a broad range of treatments and services including body treatments, body massages, spa therapy treatments, aromatherapy massage, Indian head massage and reflexology.

Students must have undertaken the Provide body massage SHBBBOS002 and Provide body treatments SHBBBOS003 units or equivalent before commencing this program.

Work is typically conducted in beauty salons and day spas. The Body Specialist Program may be a stepping stone to a full Diploma of Beauty Therapy (SHB50115).

Course Duration

Full Time option 3 days per week for 23 weeks. Part Time option 1 day per week – 36 weeks.



Tuition Cost Payment Options

Payment Plan \$4,750: \$500 deposit on enrolment balance \$169.45 per week part time option or \$277.27 per week full time option (direct debit fortnightly).

Included in cost – all products, equipment and learners guides required to complete this qualification other than those listed under student requirements below.

Student Requirements

Student requirements - Uniforms: WA Academy have a set uniform for this qualification and the uniform is compulsory for attendance. Allow approximately \$300 for a beauty tunic and dress pants.

Beauty units: Students will be required to supply a towelling body wrap and headband for beauty units – these are available for purchase at WA Academy.

Portfolio: WA Academy utilizes in some units portfolios, assignments and log books to allow formative assessment through the duration of the qualification these are completed outside of class and at the students cost.

You will receive a Statement of Attainment for the units completed in partial completion of a Diploma of Beauty Therapy (SHB50115).
