ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Completion of SHBBSSC001 Incorporate knowledge of skin structure and functions into beauty therapy, SHBBSSC002 Incorporate knowledge of body structures and functions into beauty therapy, SHBXCCS006 Promote healthy nutritional options in a beauty therapy context and SHBBBOS008 Provide body massages must be completed prior to undertaking this unit.

A minimum age requirement of 15 years of age is required to enrol into this unit.

Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) Assessment: As a requirement of the student entry procedure, students may have to undertake a Language Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment. This is assessed on a case-by-case scenario.
