Student Requirements

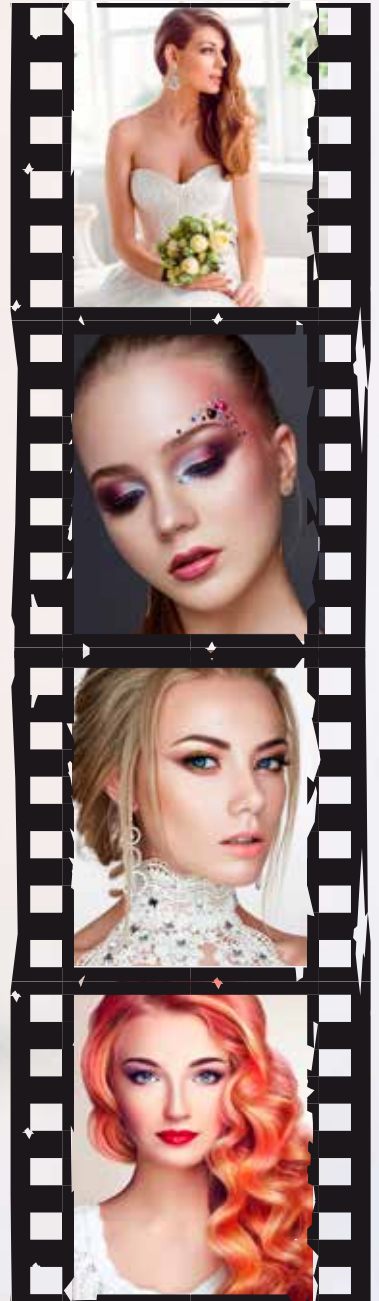
Uniforms: WA Academy uniform top to be worn with black professional pants and enclosed black shoes.

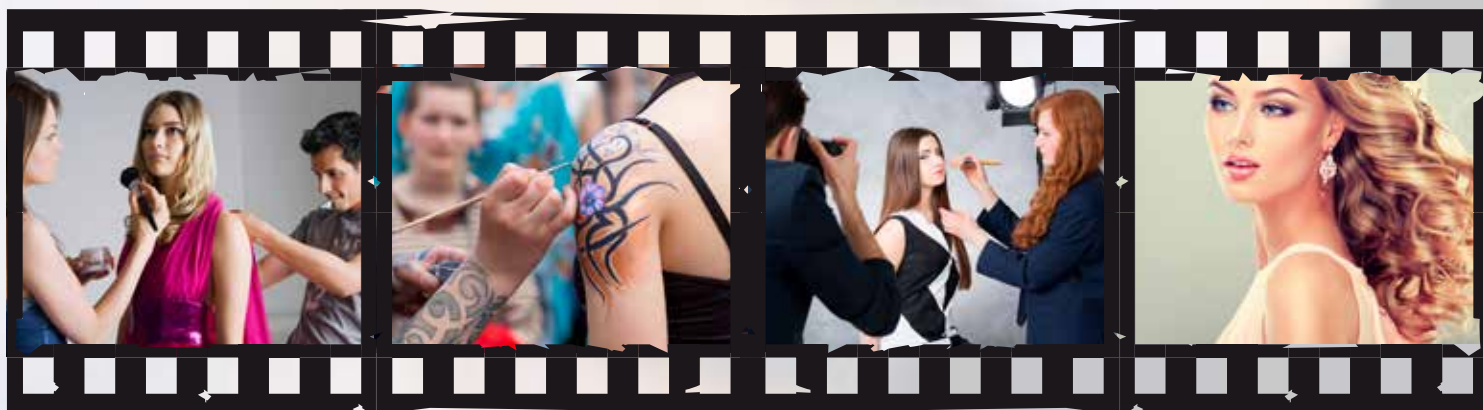
