If you are passionate about beauty and skincare, the SHB50121 Diploma of Beauty Therapy will allow you to transform that passion into a rewarding career.

This qualification provides you with the education in the fundamentals of the skin and body, paired with practical skills, techniques and diagnostic skills. The hands-on approach to the course ensures that you confident and skilled in performing a wide range of facial and body treatments, along with make-up and nail services.

The qualification has 3 streams of electives you can choose to assist you in creating the qualification that suits you and your future career aspirations.

In this qualification you will learn how to provide a broad range of beauty therapy treatments and services including:

- Provide waxing, lash and brow services
- Provide nail services, including manicures and pedicures with use of the electric file
- Design and apply basic day & evening make-up looks
- Apply eyelash extensions
- Facial treatments including specialised facial treatments and micro-dermabrasion
- Body massage and spa therapy treatments including nutrition and well-being
- Aromatherapy and Stone Therapy massage
- Employ sales techniques and advise on products and services
- Conduct salon financial transactions in a salon environment
- Safe hygiene and work practices and infection control

Graduates of SHB50121 Diploma of Beauty Therapy qualification will acquire the skills and techniques used by leading beauty therapists in the industry.

CAREER OUTCOMES

Successful completion of this qualification leads to exciting career opportunities in the beauty and spa industry. Graduates from Diploma of Beauty Therapy qualification are able to gain employment as:

- Spa therapist

ADDITIONAL STUDY/TRAINING

All streams include approximately 6 additional hours per week of prescribed reading, learner guides and workbook activities, knowledge questions and assignments (as applicable) that is to be completed off-campus.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements for this course, other than a minimum age requirement of 15 years of age.

Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) Assessment: As a requirement of the student entry procedure, students may have to undertake a Language Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment. This is assessed on a case-by-case scenario.





STUDENT REQUIREMENTS & ADDITIONAL FEES

- WA Academy beauty uniform tunic to be worn with black professional pants and black enclosed shoes.
- Student will be required to supply a toweling body wrap and headband.
- General stationery and a padlock for use of the lockers.
- Students are to purchase a Make-up Kit from WA Academy which includes a brush set, make-up products, strip eyelashes and tools required to complete their qualification.
- Students are required to supply models for all practical assessments to demonstrate their technical skills.
- The Training Package stipulates that all practical assessments must be performed on a variety of models.
- Models are also required to pay the model assessment fee charge as assessments must be performed on a paying client.
